




Public Funding for Research (Source : ERA Key Figures 2005, EC)

- ➔ "Too much fragmentation and costly duplication. We must spend our resources more efficiently and achieve critical mass."
- → " ... adopt a more strategic approach to innovation"
- → Innovation partnerships: challenge driven, addressing the whole research and innovation chain and streamlining simplifying and better coordinating existing instruments and initiatives.

To develop and strengthen the coordination of public research **programmes** carried out at national or at regional level.

"**Programmes**" should be understood as entire research programmes, or parts of such programmes, or similar initiatives having the following characteristics:

- 1. be strategically planned
- 2. be carried out at national or regional level
- 3. be financed or managed directly by national or regional public bodies, or by structures closely related (e.g. agencies)



All participants should be either:

- programme owners, such as national ministries or regional authorities managing a research programme
- programme managers (e.g. research councils, agencies) which implement research programmes under programme owners' supervision
- in justified cases: programme owners without a research programme but planning to set up one

Participants from at least 3 different MS or AS

In addition to the minimum number of participants **other legal entities** (e.g. charities) managing research programmes, may participate



A step by step approach is proposed:


ERA-NET may include the following **activities** to foster coordination and cooperation between programmes:

- 1 Systematic exchange of information & best practice
- 2 Definition and preparation of joint activities
- 3 Implementation of joint activities
- 4 Funding of transnational research → Joint calls!!!






Joint call participation in Energy ERA-NETs







Joint call participation in Industrial Technologies and SMEs ERA-NETs




Initial ambitions shown by the level of participation appeared to have been matched by the number and level of funding contributions. (See Final Report, Volume 4, Section 2.7)

The ERA-NET scheme Lessons learnt

- Immediate success in FP6 with programme owners and managers participating more than 1000 times in over 70 ERA-NET actions.
- Majority of ERA-NETs succeed in launching joint calls *FP6 ERA-NETs:* >1.100 *M*€ by the end of 2008 *FP6/FP7 ERA-NETs* & *ERA-NET+:* ≈ 2.000 *M*€ by now
- ERA-NETs fill a gap between national and FP projects
 Smaller consortia, strong SMEs participation
- Broad variety of other joint activities underpinning the success of transnational programme cooperation.
- Enabler for Joint Programming.








If MS put together 20 M€, the Commission will provide up to 10 M€, for a total budget of up to 30 M€



- 5 participants of 5 different Member or Associated States
- Joint call of minimum 5 M€ (Total budget)
- Maximum duration of 5 years



- Part A: No adjustments to ranked list after peer review are allowed
- Part B: Normally no change at the limit of the reserve list Only in well justified cases (NOT due to national return)


