


Piloting coordination of R&I resources in support of HEI cooperation (new)



Horizon 2020 support to European Universities

- Horizon 2020 complementary funding (for 39 alliances) 30% partners from widening countries
- Support for institutional change in key R&I areas (via grant to identified beneficiaries)





- Mid-term review of first generation of 17 alliances on H2020 support: summer 2022
 - Preliminary analysis: acceleration of change for all partners through inclusive cooperation



European Strategy for Universities

Flagship

- "Expand to **60 European Universities** with more than **500 universities** by mid-2024, with an Erasmus+ indicative budget totaling EUR 1.1 billion for 2021-2027"
- "Erasmus+ European Universities initiative, in combination with Horizon Europe, Digital Europe and other EU and national instruments, will support ambitious transnational alliances of higher education institutions"

Anticipated added value of a European Excellence Initiative

- Focus on <u>global competitiveness in R&I</u>
 - most promising networks of universities only
 - competition for inclusive "excellence in science and value creation"
- Accelerate R&I role of universities in <u>key EU policy areas</u> (such as Green Deal, Missions)
- <u>Implement ERA Policy Agenda</u> transformations (assessment reform, careers, ecosystems,...)







WIDERA WP 2023-2024 in a nutshell

Destinations

- Improved access to Excellence:
 - 7 calls, 8 topics; call deadlines 12/4/2023, 28/9/2023, 7/3/2024 and 26/9/2024
- Attracting and mobilising the best talents
 - 4 calls; call deadlines 7/3/2024 and 26/9/2024, and 2 aligned to MSCA 13/9/2023 and 11/9/2024
- Reforming and enhancing the EU research and innovation system
 - 2 calls, 24 topics; call deadlines 9/3/2023 and 12/3/2024

Budget

~900 M€ of which ~445 M€ on topics/actions 2023, ~455 M€ on topics/actions 2024

Destination #1 ACCESS:

Excellence funding for HEIs



- Coordination and Support Action
- Aim: to raise excellence in science & value creation in HEIs, and increase global visibility and competitiveness
- Support to implement ERA priorities, through inclusive and integrated collaboration in alliances of HEIs

Budget EUR 54 million (tbc)

HORIZON-WIDERA-2023-ACCESS-03

Call closure: 12 April 2023 (tbc)

- Competitive support for inclusive alliances of HEIs, for joint R&I agenda
- Implementation of ERA Policy Agenda, incl. attractive careers, digital transition, sharing resources and infrastructures
- Up to 20% budget for research activities
- Emphasis on widening countries
